

# OCTOBER FLOWER SHOW

## HORTICULTURAL

- Class 1 Aconitum (Monkshood)
- Class 2 Branch showing fall colour - Not over 36" from top of vase
- Class 3 Branch showing fruit - Not over 36" from top of vase
- Class 4 Cactus or Succulent - any variety, 1 pot
- Class 5 Chrysanthemum - single - 1 spray
- Class 6 Chrysanthemum - double - 1 spray
- Class 7 Coleus - 1 cultivar - 3 stems
- Class 8 Collection of garden flowers, may include branches and grasses - minimum 5 different cultivars, 1 ENTRY PER EXHIBITOR
  
- Class 9 Herbs - 3 stems, one each of 3 different cultivars
- Class 10 Ornamental grass - 1 cultivar - 3 stems
- Class 11 Sedum - any cultivar - 3 stems
- Class 12 Zinnia - 1 bloom
- Class 13 Any other perennial not listed - 1 bloom or stem
- Class 14 Any other annual not listed - 1 bloom or stem
- Class 15 Any vegetable - 1 large or 3 small specimens, same cultivar, on a plate
- Class 16 Any fruit - 3 specimens, same cultivar
- Class 17 3 different seed stalks

## DESIGN **Theme: All Hallows Eve**

- Class 18 'Welcome to My Nightmare' - a design using a Halloween character such as ghosts or bats

## MEMBERS CHOICE

- Class 19 A carved or decorated pumpkin of any theme.  
Entry will be judged by members.

Entries must be on the table by 7:15 p.m.

- Competition is open to all members in good standing of Streetsville Horticultural Society
- Exhibitors should fill out their own entry forms for each exhibit.
- One entry per exhibitor permitted in each CULTURAL and DESIGN class unless otherwise stated.
- If two or more exhibitors show the same garden and wish to compete in the same CULTURAL class, they must enter different cultivars. The cultivars must be named.
- All entries are to be as stated, and in accordance to size in Ontario Judging and Exhibiting Standards, Publication #34.
- Entry will be disqualified if not in accordance with the description of class.
- Where a definite number is called for, NO MORE or NO LESS shall be entered.
- The use of protected or endangered native plants will disqualify the exhibit.
- The decision of the judge(s) shall be final.
- No Awards will be given for mediocre exhibits.
- Exhibitors must supply own appropriate containers.
- ONLY Show Committee may move entries in the Cultural Section.
- Entries must be on the table by the stated time - 7:15 p.m. deadline and must be left on the table until the Show Convenor releases the entries. Times for entering will be strictly enforced.
- The Flower Show Handbook is available to be ordered from the OHA website.
- "Best in Show" will be left to the discretion of the Judge(s).
